

Working Bibliography: Print, Database and Website Sources

Print Sources (Books)

Author	Title of Book	Publisher	City	Date	Pages Used	Call # and ISBN*

**The call number is located on the spine of the book. (Ex. 971.04 BLI) It is not part of the citation, but it will help you find the book again in the library.*

The ISBN (International Standard Book Number) is the book's bar code. It is a 10 or 13 digit number found on the back of the book or on the verso page. Use it to create a citation shortcut in Noodle Tools.

Database Sources (Sources accessed via the library databases like EBSCO, Gale, WorldBook etc.)

Author	Title of Article and Publication (if applicable)	Name of Database and URL	Publisher Name and City	Date Published	Date Accessed	Type of Source*

**These may be reference, journal, magazine, news sources etc. Know what type of source it is, and which database you found it in for your Noodle Tools citation.*

Websites (Sources freely accessed on the web)

Author*	Title of Web Page or Article	Name of Website and URL	Publisher of the Website	Date Published	Date Accessed

**If no author is found, leave it blank. Date published or updated may only be a year. Date accessed should include day, month and year.*
